



2023 Proposed Capital Projects

Three (3) New - 2023 Capital Budget Request

- Increase the size of the Caledon East OPP parking lot for the staff, patrol vehicles and visitors to accommodate an increase in vehicle traffic due to growth. Total budget is \$835,064 funded by the OPP Capital Infrastructure Reserve
- A new ancillary facility was constructed in 2022 as a secure facility for OPP seizures and storage. This project finalizes the facility with the installation of the solar panels to feed the facility and reduce energy costs. Total budget is \$176,192 funded by the OPP Capital Infrastructure Reserve
- The Town of Caledon is going to grow at a fast pace over the next 30 years. The scope of this project is to create a master plan to address current and future policing needs and forecast the cost of that growth and the potential needs and locations for the necessary infrastructure to service future growth. Total budget is \$100,000 funded by the OPP Capital Infrastructure Reserve.

Reserve fund balances have sufficient funds to fund proposed 2023 OPP capital projects and proposed draws to fund the operating budget

- \$4.7 million Caledon Policing Stabilization Reserve
- \$6.6 million OPP Capital Infrastructure Reserve
