# **CWELCC Expansion Highlights**



Ministry released 2023 CWELCC Guideline and Access and Inclusion Framework



New spaces will include both not-forprofit and for-profit in home-based and centre-based settings targeted to reflect communities of need


Child care providers interested in participating in CWELCC must apply



Approval into the CWELCC program is not guaranteed and based on funding availability



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#### **Child Care System Spaces**

## **Auspice Targets**

- Peel is required to maintain our current system ratio of Not-For-Profit to For-Profit spaces for children aged 0-5 years.
- Currently Peel has:
  - 60% not-for-profit spaces
  - 40% for-profit spaces
- A minimum of 7,170 not-for-profit spaces must be created as part of Peel Region's CWELCC expansion plan
- Remaining 4,810 spaces can be operated by forprofit providers.

# **Age Group Targets**

Based on current enrolment and child care demand data, we are restricting expansion to the age categories:

INFANT



TODDLER



PRESCHOOL



Note: We will monitor enrolment and statistical trends throughout the expansion plan and will provide updates to the child care sector on this requirement.



# **Peel's CWELCC Multi-Year Expansion Plan** and Application **Process**




How to Apply to Expand in Peel There are a few steps for you to complete as part of the Expansion Application process:

- □ Step 1: Do your research
- □ Step 2: Determine if you are eligible
- □ Step 3: Learn how applications will be assessed
- Step 4: Complete the Region's CWELCC Multi-Year Expansion Application Form
- □ Step 5: Application results

If approved, you will receive a contract for your CWELCC funding. You will also receive your start up grant if you applied and are approved. You will be required to provide updates on your project as you work toward being licensed.

## Before you apply...Step 1: Do your Research



Expansion Mapping Tool Demo Our <u>EYCC Mapping Tool</u> has been updated to now show the priority communities

- 1. Select the Review Areas box and the map will be highlighted to show the Priority Communities
- 2. Select the Service Delivery Area
- 3. Adjust the Filters based on your needs
  - Add or Remove schools, child care centres, school age
- Input your postal code search on the top right-hand side of the map to see if it falls within a priority community or not.

## **Step 2: Determine if you are eligible to apply**

## Centre-based Child Care Providers

- currently participating in Peel's CWELCC program and planning to increase spaces through licence revision
- currently participating in Peel's CWELCC program and planning to open a new child care site in Peel
- new provider opening a new child care site in Peel
- opted-out of CWELCC in 2022 and did not apply through the 2023 Expression of Interest (EOI) process released on May 17, 2023.

### Home Child Care Agency

- currently taking part in Peel's CWELCC program and planning to revise your existing licence to add more homes
- would like to open a new LHCC agency with a head office in Peel

## Do not need to apply:

School sites with approval for a child care capital project

Space expansion in CCLS before Jan. 1 and submitted an EOI

LHCC agencies with head office outside Peel

LHCC agencies adding homes within existing licence

## **Step 3 – Learn how applications are reviewed?**

**Meet Provincial Requirements:** 



Be actively pursuing a licence, or licence revision under CCLS



Current licence under CCLS in good standing approved by EDU



Demonstrate financial viability



Assessed against Peel Region's criteria

#### Step 3a: Learn about the Centre-Based Application Criteria

Centre-based child care main criteria:

We will also consider:

Are located in one of Peel's identified priority communities or within a 2 kilometre radius of a priority community

Meet the demand for child care programs in that community

Base wages that you pay to Registered Early Childhood Educators (RECEs) or Director-approved staff (that fill the position of a RECE) align with <u>Peel's 2022</u> <u>living wage</u> of \$23.15/hr.

If the new spaces are co-located (in school, faith-based building, community centre, affordable housing)

If the new spaces improves access to child care

If the new spaces improve inclusion for underrepresented groups

## **Step 3b: Learn about the Home Child Care Agency Application Criteria**



New LHCC agencies - encouraged but not required to open homes in a priority community.

We will review these applications to assess:


- How much the base wages that you pay to Home Visitors (RECEs) align with <u>Peel's 2022 living wage</u> of \$23.15/hr.
- If the new spaces **improve access** to child care such as offering evening care, extended hours of care, weekend care or flexible care options for families.
- If the new spaces improve inclusion for underrepresented groups.

# NEW! CWELCC Start-up Grant



#### **Start-up Grant**

- Start-up Grant is available to offset costs to create new community-based, licensed full-day child care spaces in centres and home child care. The grant can be used for equipping/furnishing new spaces and/or for minor renovation projects.
- You can apply for a Start-up Grant as part of your application to enrol into Peel's CWELCC program.
- To receive a **Start-up Grant**, you must commit to these requirements:
  - $\circ~$  Enrol and participate in CWELCC until 2026
  - $\circ~$  Create new licensed spaces in priority communities
    - Spaces must be community-based, full-day spaces for children aged 0-4
  - $\circ$   $\,$  License to maximum capacity  $\,$
  - $\circ$   $\,$  Spend the grant within two years
  - o For LHCCs: Maintain number of approved spaces in service area for duration of CWELCC agreement



## Start-up Grant (cont'd)

- For Minor Renovations, as relevant to project scope, you are responsible to:
  - Contact your local municipality to discuss project scope and understand the relevant guidelines, zoning and by-law requirements
  - Hire professional consultant (e.g., architect, engineer) and contractor services
  - $\,\circ\,$  Establish a site safety plan for staff and children
  - Meet all Ministry of Education licensing requirements
  - $\,\circ\,$  Keep us up to date on project status and budget
