


Barry's Wastewater Treatment Crossword

10. A large machine used to burn biosolid waste at very high temperatures.

11. Solid waste collected during wastewater treatment

13. The wastewater tank where oxygen is added to allow good bacteria to eat any bad materials and bacteria.

2. The wastewater tank where the good bacteria sink to the bottom of the tank after breaking down the bad bacteria.

3. The tank where wastewater is given time to settle.

4. Water that goes down the drain or toilet from your home.

5. Heavy material that sinks to the bottom of the settling tank.

7. The grease, fats and oils that float to the top of the settling tank.

8. The lake that clean wastewater is returned to.
