Workshop Overview

This workshop will provide an overview of strategies to work with youth that are facing multiple barriers. Participants will learn about 'The Theory of Change' and be provided with effective tools, such as the Vulnerable Youth Spectrum along with best practices on how to engage vulnerable youth. Current trends and issues facing youth will be discussed throughout the workshop with a focus on solution-oriented approaches and partnership opportunities to address these issues.

By the end of the workshop, participants will have a better understanding of strategies and tools to engage hard-to reach and vulnerable youth who are experiencing multiple barriers.
