Background	The following five homelessness programs have been consolidated into the Community Homelessness Prevention Initiative (CHPI) beginning on January 1, 2013:	
	 Consolidated Homelessness Prevention Program Emergency Energy Fund Emergency Hostel Services Domiciliary Hostel Program Provincial Rent Bank 	
	The merging of these programs is meant to streamline housing and homeless programs into a housing service managed at the municipal level.	
	Under the CHPI, Region of Peel as the Service Manager has greater flexibility to use this funding to address local priorities and to better meet the needs of individuals and families who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless.	
Service Manager's Role	Service Managers will update all information to reflect the exclusion of payments received under the CHPI and/or CHPI-funded programs as income for the purpose of geared-to-income rent calculation.
