

It's an exciting time to live, work, and play in Peel Region.


We are planning for <u>over</u> 500,000 new residents and more than 250,000 new jobs by 2041.

The Region has saved and deferred over half a billion dollars in costs associated with growth by streamlining processes, identifying efficiencies, and through early and ongoing collaboration.


Estimated Growth Expenditures to 2041 - \$9 billion

Water and Wastewater Master Plan




- Ensures we have the capacity to provide water and wastewater services to Peel's new and future communities
- Considers the need, timing and costs of servicing and infrastructure




