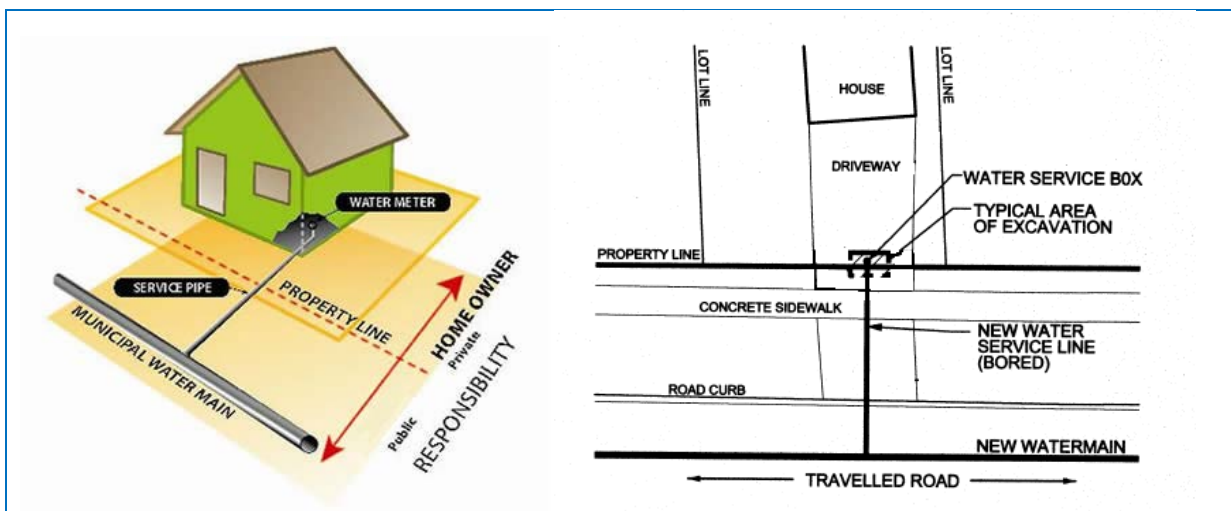

PROJECT UPDATE

WATERMAIN AND WASTEWATER MAIN REPLACEMENT AND IMPROVEMENT SANFORD CRESCENT CITY OF BRAMPTON

Update

- The new watermain and sanitary sewer on **Sanford Crescent** have now been installed. The next phase is to put the watermain and sanitary sewer into service. Properties on these streets will now have their individual water lines and sanitary laterals transferred from the old to the new.
- A new water service line and sanitary lateral will be brought up to the property line where a new water service box will also be installed. Where possible your water line will be brought up to the property line using trenchless methods. However, **the area around the water service box will be excavated including the area for the new sanitary lateral.**



When?

- We expect to start work on or about the week of June 19, 2017 on Sanford Crescent.
- The project should be completed by the end of June 2017. All work is under warranty for two years from the completion date.
- We will start restoring the road when all water and wastewater system replacements and transfers are complete, and as weather permits.
