ON SKEGBY ROAD AND CARTER DRIVE

What are we doing?

- Completing restoration following upgrade of the water distribution and sanitary sewer systems.
- Reinstating driveways, road, sod, and curb following the replacement of the watermain and services along Carter Drive and Skegby Road.

When?

- We expect to start restoration on or about June 22, 2020.
- The project should be completed before September 2020.

Traffic and Parking Control

- We may need to reduce traffic to a single lane during construction, or even temporarily close portions of the entire road.
- If we must reroute traffic, we will place signs giving directions.
- Construction barrels will be placed along the curbs for portions of Skegby Road and Carter Drive to prevent vehicles from parking in areas where we will be working. Please avoid parking near them.

Curbs and Sidewalks

- Curbs will be temporarily restored with asphalt. Sidewalks will be restored with concrete.
- Due to the condition of existing curbs and sidewalks not impacted by our project, the City of Brampton will repave Skegby Road and Carter Drive in 2022, pending Council approval. At that time, the City of Brampton will permanently restore the curbs and damaged sidewalks.

Driveway Access

- Due to construction activities, we may need to block your driveway for a short time. We will contact you before we do this to arrange for the best time and for alternate access, if needed.
- Please call the Project Manager if you have special needs related to access or business hours.

Replacing and Taking Care of Your Sod

- The contractor will take care of any sod we replace for 30 days.
- You can help the sod to stay healthy by watering it for one hour in the early morning, two or three times a week. This is especially important in hot or dry weather.
- We will replace your sod as soon as we can, but there may be a short delay.
- It is very common for the work area to settle a bit following construction. If you notice any settlement, please let the project manager or inspector know and we will ensure the contractor fixes it.

Repairing Your Driveway

- **The City of Brampton has scheduled Carter Drive and Skegby Road Rehabilitation in 2022, pending Council approval.** During Roadway Rehabilitation works, a portion of most driveways will be disturbed again along the curb and sidewalk.
- If we damaged a portion of your **asphalt driveway**, a temporary asphalt patch will be installed by our watermain contractor. Following the City of Brampton's work your driveway will be replaced in the disturbed area from edge to edge across the driveway.
- We will repair your driveway as soon as we can, but there may be a short delay.

Project Updates

- The Region of Peel will always let you know if there are any major changes to the plans.
- We will try to disturb you as little as possible.
- Please call the project manager or inspector if you have any problems or special needs.
