UPDATE - CONSTRUCTION WORK IN YOUR NEIGHBOURHOOD

As we previously communicated, the Region of Peel has started Phase 2 construction of the Cawthra Road sanitary sewer and watermain. This work is part of the Region's multi-phased project to reduce basement flooding by diverting wastewater flow away from areas prone to surcharging, as well as expanding sanitary sewer capacity and upgrading the water system capacity.

This notice is a follow up to let you know that we are returning to Silver Creek Boulevard to replace a short section of watermain at the Cawthra Road intersection.

To minimize the construction related impact (water interruptions) the watermain connection work will be completed **overnight on September 14 between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. and into the morning September 15**. The source noise will be at the intersection of Cawthra Road and Silver Creek Boulevard. The date may be rescheduled to another day within a week of September 14 due to weather or other construction factors.

A Noise Control Bylaw 360-79 exemption has been granted by the City of Mississauga. The Region is committed to monitor the job-site noise levels to ensure noise levels are within acceptable limits.
