PROJECT UPDATE – LEAF PICKUP SCHOMBERG AVENUE AND GLORENE COURT

In the fall, the City of Mississauga provides a vacuum leaf pickup service on streets that are more than 35 years old and have many large mature trees. This fall, the City will be on your street collecting the leaves on **Monday, November 16, 2020**.

PREPARING FOR LEAF PICKUP

- Rake leaves to the curb or ditch a day or two before the start of your collection week.
- Don't mix other items such as wood, bricks or brush as they can damage equipment and injure workers.
- Keep the road and curbside storm drains clear of raked leave.
