PROJECT UPDATE SANITARY SEWER AND WATERMAIN REPLACMENT AND IMPROVEMENT SCHOMBERG AVENUE AND GLORENE COURT CITY OF MISSISSAUGA

What are we doing?

- Temporarily restoring the road, curbs and driveways.
- Permanently restoring sidewalk bays and sod.

When?

- Restoration has commenced the remaining work should be completed by Friday, May 28, 2021.
- The City of Mississauga has scheduled Schomberg Avenue and Glorene Court for Roadway Rehabilitation in 2022. This will include new curbs and asphalt from curb to curb in 2022.

Traffic and Parking Control

- We may need to reduce traffic to a single lane during construction.
- If we have to reroute traffic, we will place signs giving directions.

Driveway Access

- Due to construction activities, we may need to block your driveway for a short time. We will contact you before we do this to arrange for the best time and for alternate access, if needed.
- We will make sure businesses have access at all times.
- Please call the Project Manager if you have special needs related to access or business hours.

Replacing and Taking Care of Your Sod

- We will replace any damaged sod as soon as we can.
- Our contractor will take care of the new sod for the first 30 days after it's laid down. After that, you can help the sod stay healthy by watering it early in the morning two or three (2-3) times a week, especially in hot weather.
- It is very common for the work area to settle a bit after construction. If you notice any settlement, please let the project manager or inspector know and we will ensure the contractor fixes it.

Repairing Your Driveway

- The City of Mississauga has scheduled Schomberg Avenue and Glorene Court for Roadway Rehabilitation in 2022. During Roadway Rehabilitation works, a portion of most driveways will be disturbed again along the curb.
- A temporary asphalt patch will be installed around the water services box. Following the City
 of Mississauga's work your driveway will be replaced in the disturbed area from edge to
 edge across the driveway.
- If we damaged a portion of your **interlock driveway**, our contractor will fully reinstate to ensure driveway material is secured until the City of Mississauga commences their works.
- If we damaged a portion of your **concrete driveway**, it will be fully reinstated by the Region of Peel
- We will repair your driveway as soon as we can, but there may be a short delay.

Repairing the Road, Driveway Aprons, Curbs, and Sidewalks

- All sections of curbs impacted by the watermain/sanitary main construction shall be temporarily restored by the Region with asphalt curbs this year. The City of Mississauga shall restore them with permanent concrete curbs as part of their works.
- All sidewalk bays impacted by the watermain construction shall be permanently restored this spring.
- As part of the overall improvement in your neighborhood, the City of Mississauga shall resurface your street as part of their road resurfacing program, scheduled in 2022.

Project Updates

- The Region of Peel will always let you know if there are any major changes to the plans.
- We will try to disturb you as little as possible.
- Please call the project manager or inspector if you have any problems or special needs.
