PROJECT UPDATE SANITARY SEWER REPLACMENT CAWTHRA ROAD FROM BURNHAMTHORPE ROAD EAST TO BLOOR STREET

What are we Doing?

- In the next few days, you will see various construction activities (such as large sized equipment being mobilized) at the Bloor Street and Cawthra Road compound area to remove the tunnel boring machine.
- Work from now until competition will include cleaning and testing of the new sewer, manhole installation and restoration of the shaft compound once all underground work is complete.

Working Hours

- Our contractor's normal working hours are from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. These hours are consistent with the local municipality's bylaws. We understand this may cause some inconvenience, but a shorter working day would mean the work would take longer to complete.
- Works are expected to be completed late fall 2021.

Noise Level

• You may notice some noise and vibrations from the upcoming construction activities. We will do everything possible to keep the noise to a minimum.

Traffic, Driveway and Parking Information

- We will manage traffic to minimize disruption to vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians.
- We may need to temporarily reduce traffic to a single lane during some portions of work.
- Due to construction activities, we may need to block your driveway for a short time. We will contact you before we do this to arrange for the best time and for alternate access, if needed.
- On-street parking will be reduced during construction.
